There has been a government consultation on trade deals. It has been open for three months but it will close at midnight tomorrow. Some of us have completed the online form but we have not had much advance warning about this action.

Pint of Politics

A couple of us went to an event in the Green Dragon Theatre a couple of weeks ago. The focus was Industrial Teesside but it is one of a series of meetings on different topics. There were about thirty people present. We should think about this as a possible venue for a future talk on one of our campaigns as we would have a readymade venue and audience. The green candidate for Scarborough and Whitby would be willing to speak, David Malone.

Farmers Market

We have not done a stall this year so agreed that we would go to the November market. We agreed to focus on food waste which is not a GJN campaign but we can make it relevant as we really need a food based campaign if we are to use the market as a venue.

Pharmaceuticals Game
